Description

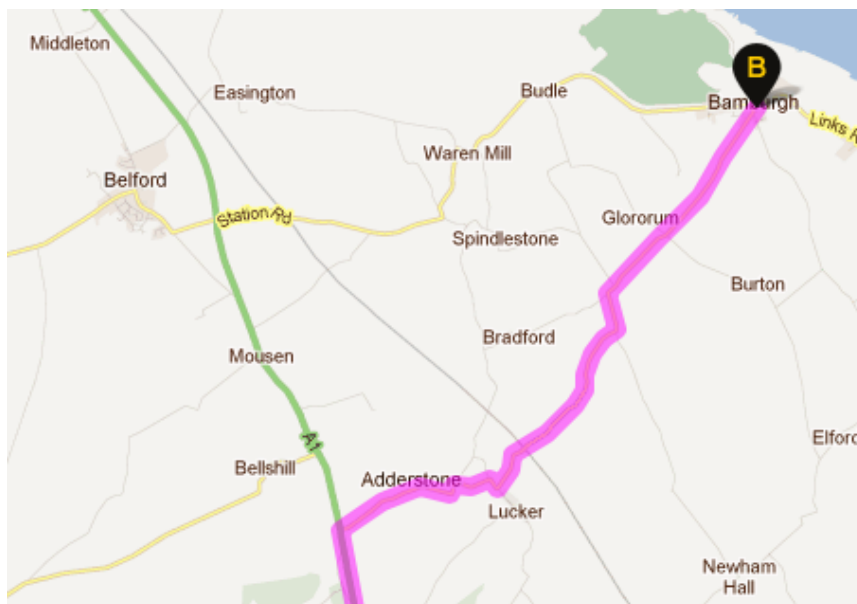
With its wild coastline, rolling hills and rugged moors, Northumberland is one of England's most stunning landscape locations. Using a combination of unique exercises, hands-on coaching, image feedback and plenty of time in the field, you will learn all the skills necessary to move your photography to a new level.

The meeting point for the course is reception area of the Victoria Hotel, 1 Front Street, Bamburgh, NE69 7BP. Please arrive for a 9:00AM start.

How to get there

From the A1 turn onto the B1341 signposted Bamburgh. After approximately 4.5 miles bear right onto Front Street (B1340). The hotel is on your right.

Accommodation

Accommodation is provided on Friday and Saturday night in a single or double en-suite room (no single supplement) at the Victoria Hotel, Bamburgh. The hotel has complimentary Wi-Fi.

Breakfast on days 2 and 3 will be taken in the field. A buffet lunch is provided on days 1 and 2. Additional meals, including dinner, may be taken at leisure and are not included in the course fee.

What to bring

The weather in Northumberland in spring is likely to be variable and unpredictable. Therefore, please bring clothing suitable for all conditions, including rainwear and cold weather. Clothing is best worn in layers. A pair of good walking shoes or boots is recommended for this trip, along with hat and gloves. This course is suitable for most people. There is some moderate walking involved, including a short but relatively steep slope leading up from Durdle Door/St Oswald's Bay. All walks are less than one mile on generally flat, even terrain.
